Norway's Coastal Voyage August 8-17, 2017

8/8 Day 1 Overnight Flight

Depart USA for an overnight flight to Norway.

8/9 Day 2 Arrive in Bergen

After your overnight flight you arrive in Bergen and will be transferred from the airport to your hotel in Bergen. You will have time to explore the charming port and Hanseatic city of Bergen independently.

8/10 Day 3 Embarkation in Bergen

After an included breakfast at your hotel you may want to stroll through the narrow streets of the medieval Hanseatic Bryggen quarter. You will be transferred from the hotel to the Hurtigruten Quay in the afternoon. Cabins will be ready at 6:00pm and a buffet dinner will welcome you onboard.

8/11 Day 4 Ålesund – Geirangerfjord - Ålesund

Your ship navigates past skerries and islands further north to Ålesund. Explore the inspiring architecture in the Apotekergata and Kongensgate pedestrian areas, perfect examples of the art nouveau style. Your Hurtigruten ship sails into the spectacular Geirangerfjord - acclaimed by National Geographic and placed on UNESCO's list of World Heritage Sites. En route we pass sheer, 2600ft high cliffs and impressive waterfalls.

8/12 Day 5 The Royal City of Trondheim

In the old royal city of Trondheim you can enjoy a good view from the Gamle Bybrua ("Old Town Bridge"). This neo-gothic wooden bridge dating from 1861 used to be the only way into the town center. The Nidaros Cathedral, built in the period 1070 to 1300, is Norway's largest Gothic religious edifice. We then set course for the northwest, past the beautiful Kjeungskjær lighthouse and thousands of little islands and picturesque rocky outcrops.

8/13 Day 6 Arctic Circle and Lofoten Islands

In the morning we cross the Arctic Circle (66°33' N) between Nesna and Ørnes, marked by a globe on a small islet. Passengers sailing in Arctic waters for the first time are given an Arctic Circle baptism by Neptune, the ruler of the Seven Seas. When the "Lofoten Wall" appears on the horizon, a mountain range of up to 3280ft high, the Landegode, Helligvær and Vestfjord are behind you. In the evening we reach Svolvær, the main settlement on the Lofoten Islands.

8/14 Day 7 Tromsø, the gateway to the Arctic

During the night the ship navigates the narrow Raftsund strait. After a stop in Harstad we continue via Finnsnes to Tromsø for a longer stay. With the presence of the Norwegian Polar Institute, the city has cemented its position as the polar capital of Norway. "Ishavskatedralen", The Arctic Cathedral, is the most famous landmark with its progressive design and extraordinary stained glass window.

8/15 Day 8 Honningsvåg and the North Cape

Honningsvåg is the nearest port to the North Cape. An excursion to this breathtaking site puts you at 71° 10' 21" N, only 2,000 kilometers from the Geographical North Pole. Join the presentation of the Sámi culture and history in pictures, words and music. Later on we pass a rock formation that is sacred to the Sámi people, Finnkirka.

8/16 Day 9 Debarkation in Kirkenes – Flight to Oslo

When you arrive in Kirkenes, at longitude 30° east, you are actually further east than Istanbul and St. Petersburg. This is debarkation port for the voyage north. You will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Oslo. There will be time to explore downtown Oslo and the historic waterfront.

8/17 Day 10 Depart Oslo for Home

After an included breakfast at your hotel it will be time to depart for home. You will be taking with you many fond memories of Norway and unique experience to share with family and friends.
